As an extension of Kavitha Holistic Approach, established in 2013, the study group generally offers 1 to 2 webinars a month. Over the course of two years, more than 40 educational webinars were hosted by Kavitha Kukunoor. These webinars formed the seeds for KHA Study Group to sprout. Sharing, good-will, and solid clinical work within the classical model are **foundational principals** for KHA. Following each webinar, attendees may fill out a Jot Form, to receive a Continuing Education Certificate, for both CHC and non-CHC attendees. By virtue of Kavitha's charisma and commitment to service in the field of homeopathy, she gathers and brings together dynamic, like-minded teachers and guest presenters. The group also uniquely supports Stage 4 cancer survivors. The faculty bring a high level of practice and excellence to the group, while getting down to the bones of discussing real-life challenges. You could call it *Hahnemann Plus*. The webinars discuss therapeutic topics, practical approaches in case management, and case studies. Each webinar is recorded, so members may view the presentations at their own convenience, if they are unable to attend the live session, as well, KHA Homeopathy Study Group offers free recordings to CHC members. Each presenter comes from the heart, while sharing their practical pearls. This is an exciting study group, rich in substance and soul.
